## Beer and pub news.....

Looks like the Leadmill brewery as got a new brewery tap, which is the Old Oak Inn at Horsley Woodhouse.

Congratulations to Richard and all his team at the Leadmill Brewery for all their hard work!

Richard Creighton from the Leadmill Brewery is also hopeful of buying the Station Hotel in Kilburn, but no progress has been made with acquiring this pub. Negotiations are still on going, could this mean a new location for the Brewery, if a deal can be struck to buy the Station Hotel?

A recent visit to the Belvoir Brewery tap, The Sugar Loaf at Kettleby, was very disappointing with only one Belvoir beer on!

New brewery for Barnsley, called the Acorn Brewery situated at Wombwell. It is a ten barrel brewery, producing 2-3 brews per week. They commenced brewing on the 5th July 2003 and have 3.8% bitter at the moment, but hope to brew a stronger beer and a Christmas beer later.

The Black-a-moor at Troway has changed hands and is now in the hands of Justin and Lisa Willmer, who intend to keep the old policy on guest beers.

Bolsover Brewery is another new brewery that is planned shortly. Robert and Peter Agar hope to produce a range of ales and sell them in their own pubs, including the new Middle Club in Whitwell and the Woodman in Shuttlewood.

The William 1V is rumoured to be up for sale/to be sold, but Linda is yet to make a final decision. Watch this space for more information.....!
