The Mansfield & Ashfield branch of CAMRA has 2 places for branch Pub of the Year, 1 for Nottinghamshire and 1 for Derbyshire. The highest placed pub based on the National Beer Scoring System will still go forward for nomination along with any Pub of the Season winner for that area and current holders of Pub of the Year. The nominees are listed below along with their entry criteria and you may vote for up to 2 pubs for Nottinghamshire and 2 pubs for Derbyshire.

Any CAMRA member can vote but for your vote to be valid you **MUST** have submitted a score for that pub between 10th January 2018 to 9th January 2019.

Any forms submitted without a name, membership number and signature will be considered invalid.
